

Do you have regular COPD flare-ups?






If so, you may be interested in taking part in the RESOLUTE clinical study.

The aim of the study is to confirm if a medicine already used to treat another respiratory condition, can reduce the number of flare-ups in people with COPD.





Who can join?

You may be able to join if you:

-  Are aged 40–85 years
-  Have moderate to very severe COPD
-  Have experienced 2 or more flare-ups in the past year
-  Are a current smoker or ex-smoker who has smoked 20 cigarettes a day for at least 1 year
-  Have received triple combination inhaler therapy (ICS/LABA/LAMA) for 3 months or more immediately prior to joining the study

What will the study involve?

Over a minimum of 56 weeks, you will be asked to:

-  Attend appointments to have tests and assessments
-  Come to the clinic to receive the study treatment
-  Record your symptoms and medication every day using an electronic hand-held device
-  Attend follow-up appointments to monitor your health after you stop the study treatment

The findings from this study will help develop new COPD treatments and make a difference for people diagnosed with COPD in the future.
