



A clinical research study for people with bullous pemphigoid

The FJORD Study is being carried out to learn more about whether a study drug works to help improve symptoms of bullous pemphigoid. The study will also look at how safe the study drug is.

In the 36-week treatment period, half of the participants will receive a placebo (a medication that looks like the study drug but has no active ingredient) and half will receive the study drug. There will also be the option of participating in an extension treatment period, where all participants receive the study drug.

You or someone you care for may be able to take part if you/they:

- ▲ are 18 years of age or older
- ▲ have been diagnosed with bullous pemphigoid
- ▲ have symptoms such as itching and blisters.

If you take part, you will be in the study for at least 10 months and have 14 visits to the study center.

The study drug and study assessments will be provided at no cost.
